Food Vending

20x20 - \$225

Includes:

20x20 Space

Electric Hook Up

3 Vendor Passes

Beverages must be approved.

Must provide 20 meals for Staff / Artist needs.

Food vendors must bring their own clean water.

Extra vendor passes will be \$30 and limited to 2 (5 total passes) for food vendors.

Beverage Vending

10x10 - \$175

Includes:

10x10 Space (can accommodate Concession Trailer)

Electric Hook Up

2 Vendor Passes

Beverages must be approved.

Beverage vendors must bring their own clean water.

Extra vendor passes will be \$30 and limited to 2 (4 total passes) for beverage vendors.

Craft Vending

There are two levels of Craft Vending available, please note what is offered at each price level:

10x10 - \$125

Includes:

10x10 Space

Electric Hook Up

1 Vendor Pass

20x10 - \$200

Includes:

20x10 Space (20ft front)

Electric Hook Up

1 Vendor Pass

Extra vendor passes will be \$30 and limited to 2 (3 total passes) for craft vendors.

Please complete and return this application as soon as possible. If you are selected, we will send you a contract and take it from there.

OTHER INFO:

Only **2 food vendors, 1 beverage vendor, and 4-6 craft vendors** will be chosen.

Each vendor is responsible for their own sales tax and any other tax forms.

Food Vendors are responsible for Temporary Food Permit. Link on following page.

The gates will open at 12:00pm on Friday, August 28th and close at 4:00pm on Sunday, August 30th for the public.

Extra vendor passes must be purchased at least one month before the event.

All vending space locations will be determined by Jam Revival Festival Coordinators.

***Health Official - Food Permit**

A “temporary food service establishment” shall be defined for purposes of this chapter as a food service establishment which shall be in operation no more than 14 consecutive days.

(1) Any person who wishes to operate a temporary food service establishment shall notify the health official prior to opening said establishment for business. No person shall operate a temporary food service establishment without written permission from the health officials.

(2) The health official may require an otherwise temporary food service establishment to comply with all rules and regulations under this chapter as if it were a permanent food service establishment. However, the FDA Food Code provisions relating to temporary food service establishments shall apply, and the health official may allow variances from Food Code requirements provided such variances do not compromise health and safety.
